 State of Virginia, being of sound mind and
 memory do make and ordain this following
 as my last will and Testament. I give to
 Mary Ann Nicholson and Richard H. Leigh
 each a feather Bed. I give to Wm E Leigh the
 remainder of my chattel property and two
 hundred dollars in consideration of the
 care bestowed upon me by his family. I give
 the remainder of my estate to be equally
 divided between the three above named
 children. I direct my Executor to sell my
 securities, to facilitate division among
 the legates and to deposit the proceeds
 some good banking institution to the credit
 of the estate until it can be distributed
 among the heirs. I hereby constitute and
 appoint G. N. Musgrave ex. of this my last
 will and testament and authorize the Court
 to permit him to qualify as such without
 requiring any other security. Given under
 my hand and seal this 16th day of August 1879

At a Court held for the County of Southamp-
 ton on Monday Octo: 20: 1879.
 This Last Will and Testament of Charlotte
 Leigh dead, was proved by the oaths of Geo. H.
 Turner and J. D. Murfey the two subscribing
 witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded.
 And on the motion of G. N. Musgrave the
 Executor therein named, who made oath
 according to law & entered into and acknow-
 ledged a bond in the penalty of Five Thousand
 and Dollars conditioned as the law
 directs (but without security the will
 directing that none should be required
 and the Court requiring none) which bond
 is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is
 granted the said G. N. Musgrave for
 obtaining a probate of the said will in
 due form.
