I, Ben C. Tapp of the County of Southampton, in State of Virginia, do make and
publish this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills made
by me, in the manner and form following.

1st As soon after my death as may seem best to them, I wish my Executors
as who I shall hereinafter name, will either for Cash or in kind, as may
best be to them, the whole of my Chattel and personal Estate, of every
kind except that hereinafter disposed of, I wish them also to sell at their
discretion allowing them three years to do so, all the Land I may
own at my death except such as I shall hereinafter otherwise dis-
pose of, and to be sold at reasonable terms, say One third for Cash, the
balance in One One and three years time, with interest from day of sale,
and to be well secured, and to be sold either privately, or publicly, I
wish them also to close all the Bonds of Debt or mortgages I may
have due me at my death at their discretion, either for Cash, or in kind,
and when the property is conveyed in their opinion is worth my debt,
I wish them to lend the amount of my debt, and in so doing if it
falls on their hands they shall be allowed one year by deposit of funds,
either privately or publicly for the full amount of my Debt for Cash
or in kind, using their discretion.

2^d I give to my wife Caroline K. Tapp, the whole of the Tract of Land in
which I live, with all the improvements thereon including the place
that James T. Norton now lives, in all time I intend to make hereon,
except all my household and kitchen furniture at my Residence, all
my stock of every kind, from my horses, Carriages, Waggon, Harness, Hogs,
my flock of every kind except my Cow, that may be in hand or in
course of cultivation and apple Orchard, if I am here till I shall be in
need at my Residence only, and I do to avoid any delay after my
