11th I wish and my will is, that all the debts, debts and claims of my wife, children, and all other property, of any and every kind, not herein before disposed of, belonging to me, shall be divided into twenty equal shares, one of which shares I hereby give to Emily J. Woodard the wife of Jefferson J. Woodard, to her and her heirs forever.

12th I give to James D. Vardner, three of the aforesaid twenty shares to him and his heirs forever.

13th I give to Stephen S. Howard, two of the aforesaid twenty shares to him and his heirs forever.

14th I give to William B. Garland, two of the aforesaid twenty shares, to him and his heirs forever.

15th I give to Wm. S. Myrick two of the aforesaid twenty shares, to him and his heirs forever.

16th I give to Ellen D. Bannet, the wife of Joseph Bannet, One of the aforesaid twenty shares, to her and her heirs forever.

17th I give to Joseph H. Myrick, One of the aforesaid twenty shares, and to be held by his father, William S. Myrick, as (Trustee) for him.

18th I give to all the children, Margaret R. Vardner, Mary Anne Vardner, as my death, One of the aforesaid twenty shares, to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever.

19th I give to Anne M. Poyer, Corrie C. Poyer, Joseph M. Poyer and George C. Poyer, in all children of George C. Poyer and One of the aforesaid twenty shares to them and their heirs forever, to be divided equally between them, but if either Corrie C. Poyer, Joseph M. Poyer, or George C. Poyer, shall die before me, then I wish the portion of such One, or what it should be drawn from my Estate, to be paid over to the other two equally, to them and their heirs.

20th I give to Fannie L. Little, the wife of Theo. L. Little, One and the half of the aforesaid twenty shares, to her and her heirs, and if she dies Fannie L. Little shall die leaving no child, or child who before me leaving no child in either case, I give the aforesaid One share to Theobald Little, to him and his heirs.

21st I do hereby constitute and appoint as Executors my wife Caroline R. Poyer, and as Executors my friends George M. Myrick, Jefferson J. Woodard, James D. Vardner, James S. Vardner, and William S. Myrick, to see my last will and testament, and I do hereby authorize and request the said Executors that they may be allowed for probate, to be allowed all or any share of them, as given to Executors without giving any Security whatever, I also wish my said Executors to divide the whole amount of my Estate as equally between themselves as they well can.
