

Although my last and last will & testament, dated 15th November 1877,  
I requested the Court not to require  
my Executors to give a joint bond,  
but for each one to give his  
individual bond for the amount  
he may possibly take possession of.

Ordained to the my last will and testament, as directed to me the 15th  
day of November 1877, Whereas, I did in said Will in Section the 1st  
give to the Children, that is Charles H. Dandies the share of 1/3  
of my personal Estate, to be equally divided between them, & I  
directed and requested my Executors to pay over the aforesaid One share to  
the aforesaid Charles H. Dandies, at the time of paying over the  
Legacy for him to hold and control for the use and Education of  
his said Children, at his discretion, my said Executors to receive of  
the said Charles H. Dandies, as payment to him of some money for  
his share to them, in full for said share  
and Whereas I did in my aforesaid will give to Joseph C. Pope and  
George C. Pope, Children of Ben C. Pope the sum of 1/3 of a portion  
of my personal Estate, & in my said will I appointed  
Guardians for the said two Children, then pay over their portion to said  
Guardians, but if no good guardians can be gotten, then I directed my  
Executors to invest each of their Legacies in my said will, in some  
State Bonds, even if they can do no better than to take them for cash in  
bearing registered bonds, and the funds to be registered in the name of  
the Children, if it can be done, it is better to take said the principal of  
which will not be due until after said Children will be twenty one years  
old, I desired proper Mr. George C. Hargrave attorney to arrange the matter,  
I do all this to relieve my Executors from entanglement and confusion  
the interest in said Bonds can be paid to the acting Guardian of  
said Children annually, to keep, defray the expenses of said Children,  
if they should not get a legal Guardian, Given Under my hand and seal  
this 15th day of December 1877

Decided Ordained to my last will and testament, as directed by me the  
15th 1877, Whereas the Legacy I gave Joseph H. Hargrave in said Will  
I requested my Executors to pay over the same to his Pastor W. C. Hargrave  
as Trustee for him, but I am fully authorized and request my said Executors  
to pay the same over to the said Joseph H. Hargrave, his Pastor  
believes he will take care of it, I wish and will that my Executors  
may before they convert all my Estate into money, as directed under the  
Omnipotent Section of my Will, leave to Joseph C. Dandies & Co. I desire  
to request them for some thousands and thirty one years Dollars, date and  
due October 1st 1891, and the interest thereon, the Legacy I mentioned in  
my Will of the 15th November 1877, but I am now giving it to them and their  
heirs, and I desire my Executors, in the settlement of my Estate
