and declare this to be my last will and testament in manner as follows:
I desire my husband Elijah Adams in and of my heart
before his death and hold the land on which we now live, and belonging
to me by virtue of a certain deed from said Elijah Adams to me, &c.
long as he lives. I also wish said Elijah Adams to have and to hold for
life my estate of personal estate of which I may die seized and
possessed. After the death of said Elijah Adams I give and bequeath
the above named property, including estate both real and personal
to my niece Mary Jane Rollings wife of John H. Rollings
and formerly Mary Jane Williams, daughter of Augustus Williams
and Harriet Williams, to be held by her, and her heirs forever.
As to the residue of this I give to my two sisters Amanda Davis, and
Olivia Davis, each a glass butter plate.

I nominate, constitute and appoint Elijah Adams Executor of this
my last will and testament, and do hereby authorize and declare this
an act done in testamentary by me, heretofore made.
In testimony of which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal this 11th day of July, One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Ninety four.
