Know all Men by these presents, that I, Anthony Harris of the
County of Southampton, State of Virginia, being of sound mind,
do hereby declare this to be my last will and Testament,
revoking all others. I dispose of my property as follows,
after my just debts are paid.

- 1st To Crispy A. Turner, I leave that part of my landed Estate, in-
cluding the house I live in, running from a marked pine at
J. J. Woodard's line to J. H. Thomas line, where it crosses at
Phillip Brown's Land, taking in the Land South, then along the
James Land. At the death of the said Crispy A. Turner, I leave
the said Land to James T. Turner, (his son) in fee simple.
- 2^d To Priscilla Harris, (Niece as decessor), I leave that part of
my landed Estate lying North & West of the above mentioned
part, adjoining the Lands of J. J. Woodard, Norplut Brown, &c. ?
At the death of the said Priscilla Harris, I give the said Land
to Nancy Elizabeth Turner, in fee simple.
- 3^d After my debts & burial Expenses are paid, and there is any property
from my personal property left, I give or leave the same to be
equally divided between Crispy A. Turner, and Priscilla Harris,
(Daughter) In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this 20th day of October 1874.

the said Carrol Holland." Whereupon the said writing is ordered
to be recorded as the true last will & Testament of Anthony
Harris decd.
