

Then I give unto my Daughter Sarah Andrews One Negro Girl named Sarah to her and her heirs forever. I also give my said Daughter Sarah one feather Bed and furniture and one Horse saddle and Bridle.

Then My Will and desire is that my wife Anna Andrews may have the Use & benefit of the Plantations whereon I now live and all the Lands I now being about three hundred and fifty five Acres for and during her life & after her Death I desire that the said Plantation whereon I now live with the three hundred & fifty five acres may be sold by my Executors hereto mentioned for the most can be got for it and the Purchase money to be equally divided betwixt my two sons Thomas Andrews and George Andrews

Lastly I give the use of the remainder of my Estate be it of what Nature or quality ever after my just debts are paid and my funeral expences discharged to my wife Anna Andrews which is intended for the Band some Maintenance of my wife Anna during her life and after Death the remainder of my Estate it may be equally divided among my surviving Children and my Grandson Robert Andrews

And I do Constitute and appoint my sons Willm Andrews and John Andrews to be my Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and I further desire that my Estate may not be appraised And shew'd as usual and do allow all and every other former Wills Legacies Bequests and Executors by me in anywise before Named Wills and bequeathed I Give Willm Andrews whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my this day of _____ in the year of our Lord 1778
