now in Possession to her and her heirs

Item I give and bequeath my son William Taylor my Plantations whereon I have bought
is now under and the Plantations bought of Henry Adams with all the land I
hold running the same with the right of all my Negro George, Abby, Joshua, Belina
Early, Coby, and the two French boys, and my provisions which I leave to him
and his heirs forever.

Then I give a Negro called Bosmy Daughter Mary Mangri Taylor to Neg Denny
 and my Whys Cato Bob & Lydia to her and her heirs

From Miss Wigham to my Daughter Martha Taylor & Neg Nancy Tom
Call Young Abigail Cherry & Lewis to her and her heirs
From Miss Wigham to my Daughter Martha Taylor & Neg Nancy Tom

I give and bequeath to my son Robert Taylor after my wife's Death all the land
with the Mill I have lent to my wife to him & his heirs Also I give to my son
Robert all the land I sold to my wife the 3 Plantations with the six ^{1/2} Acs
of Annals young, Jacob, Lucy, Rudy, Charles and Dorah all with their heirs
I give to my son James and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath all the remainder of my Estate as aforesaid to be sold
 the better to enable my Son to pay my Death due balance to be equally divided
 between my four Children Wm Henry Mason Martha Robert and the
 Survivors of them And after the Death of my wife all the Estate Levi to her
 to be sold and equally divided between my four Children as above directed
 And lastly I do appoint my Loving Wife And Brother Henry Taylor Executor
 of this my Last Will and Testament hereby Revoking all others formerly
 made I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 1st day of Aug^r 1792
