In the Name of God Amen I W^m Hennet of the parish of St Luke New^{ark} in the County of Southampton being sick and weak but of sound and disposing mind and memory thank the goodness of almighty God for her same do make and constitute this to be my last will & Testament in form and manner following to wit Give and bequeath unto my son Edwin Hennet my Plantation and Tract of Land whereon now lies containing 350 Acres by the said son in law after the death of his mother to him and his heirs forever Give to my loving wife Ann Hennet the labour of my two slaves Boster and Ruth during her Natural life and after her death give and bequeath the said slaves to my son Edwin Hennet to him and his heirs forever I likewise give to my son Edwin Hennet my young James Bost commonly call'd I give and bequeath unto my loving son Lot Hennet my self God I named & will to him and his heirs forever together with my house call'd that we call Stover further more my will and desire is that my Copper Hill with a p[er]petu[r]e annuity thereunto belonging remain on my said Plantation for the use of the widow I likewise give to my wife another choice of one hundred and my Copper Kettle with her my will and desire is that after my just debts and funeral expenses is paid that all the remaining part of my Estate not before mentioned both real & personal to be equally divided between my sons Jacob and Shadrack Hennet to them and their heirs forever And I do appoint my Loving wife Ann my two sons Jacob & Shadrack Hennet my sole and sole Exec^t of this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all other wills by me h[as]tily done made & declare this to be my last will & mine other In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and sealed my Seal this 19 day of November 1770 — Signed Sealed and Published And declared in the presence of us
