I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Turner my Neg. Slave Christ half my Stock
 to him and his heirs forever

I give the use of My Man Simon to my Loving wife Calia Turner during her life
 Likewise

I give one grey Mare half my Stock one bed and furniture half a dog (Plates one)

Dist two Basins half a Dog Runn Yokes two Pigs one partridge and her heirs forever

All the rest of my Estate of what Nature or Kind soever or wheresoever it is found

I give to my son Joseph Turner to him and his heirs forever
 Lastly I do appoint and constitute my Loving wife Calia Turner & Arthur
 Allen to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament For
 Which purpose I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 28 day
 of October 1772
