In the name of God Amen I Allice Foster of Southampton County being sick and weak of body but of sound mind and perfect sense and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life do make and appoint this to be my last Will and Testament And first I recommend my soul to the mercy of Almighty God that gave it me and my body to be buried at the discretion of my Executors here after mentioned as to what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow on me I dispose of them in manner following

Item

I leave all my stock of Cattle and Hogs to be sold and the money thereof arising I leave to be divided in manner following Two fifth parts I give to my son Moses Foster and the other three I give to my Daughter Amey Foster I also give my Daughter Twelve pounds cash my Will and desire is that if my Daughter should die without issue that all the money above mentioned to her should return to my son Moses Foster

Item

I give to my my Grandson Elias Westbrook one feather bed and two sheets and one nine quartered Blanket to him and his heirs forever

I give my crop to be equally divided between my son Moses & my daughter Amey to them and their heirs forever

And I do appoint my son Moses Foster Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills formerly by me made and do ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the seventh day of August 1770
