

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 11th day of February 1773 — This Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of John Harris deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded

Will In the name of God Amen I Charles Taylor of the County of Southampton being weak in body tho' of sound mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following

Imprimis My Will and desire is that all my just debts be fully paid and satisfied

Item My Will and desire is that all my plantations be continued under the present Overseer and the Slaves thereon as they are now placed untill next Christmas in order for making an completing of crops thereon

Item I give and bequeath unto my cousin John Taylor son of Ethelred Taylor the plantation whereon I now live with all the land shold joining the same the same and my right to the Indian lands leased by me which Land I give to my said Cousin and his heirs for ever Also I give my said Cousin four Negroes Aaron Harry at Westbrook's Farm and Molly my Bay riding Horse Old Bird a Sorrel and a Black Horse called Turner all the Cattle Hogs and Corn that shall be upon the said plantation at the time of my death and One Hundred Barrells of Corn that shall be made (the crop succeeding my death) on the said plantation. All my House and Kitchen Furniture and plantation utensils provided my said Cousin John Taylor pay unto M^{rs} Elizabeth Cary and Benjamin Turner the Balance of my Account with them

Item I Give to my Brother in Law Samuel Smith M^r Croskey (in lieu of my sisters Legacy) the five following Slaves Phillis Jacob Mungo Yallow Harry and Yallow Hannah —

Item I Give to Charles Taylor son of John Taylor my Library of Books

Item I Give and bequeath to my loving sister Charlotte M^r Croskey all the remainder of my estate of what nature or kind soever or wheresoever found to her and her heirs for ever

Lastly I do appoint my Brother in Law Samuel Smith M^r Croskey and my Cousin John Taylor Executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and Seal this Third day of February One Thousand seven hundred and seventy three
