 the year of our Lord 1768 I Henry Dawson of Virginia in the County
 of Southamptown being in perfect health of Body and of perfect mind
 and Memory Thanks be unto God for the same and calling to mind
 the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all
 men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament

That is to say Principally and first of all I Give and recommend
 my Soul into the hands of God that gave it And for my body I
 recommend that to the earth to be buried in a Christian like
 manner at the discretion of my executors Nothing doubting but
 at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
 the mighty power of God and as touching such Worldly estate
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I Give
 devise and dispose of the same in manner and form following
 that is to say — I Give and bequeath to David Dawson
 my well beloved Son Whom I likewise constitute Make ordain
 my only and sole executor of this my last Will and Testament
