In the Name of God Amen I Phillip Claude of Southampton  
 County being in perfect health and memory and calling to mind  
 that it is meet for all men once to dye do ordain this to be  
 my last will and testament in the following manner and form  
 first of all I recommend my soul to God that gave it me and  
 my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors

Item

I give and bequeath unto my two sons Newell and Joshua  
 all my lands containing four hundred and thirty acres more  
 or less in the following manner The Manor Plantation to my  
 son Joshua Claude to him and his heirs forever to be bounded  
 Thus beginning at the North of Harrison's Branch up that  
 Branch to a marked pine from thence to a line of black  
 trees to a pine stump in the Greenlawn Branch, likewise  
 two negroes Jenny and Winy to him and his heirs forever

Item

I Give to my son Newell Claude two negroes Lydia and  
 Ben to him and his heirs for ever

My will and desire is that my wife Elizabeth Claude shall  
 have the use of my plantation during her life or widowhood  
 likewise two negroes Tom and Ben and at my wife's death
