In the Name of God Amen I Phillip Claud of Southampton
 County being imperfect health and memory and calling to mind
 that it is ordered for all men once to dyd do ordain this to be
 my last will and testament in the following manner and form
 first of all I recommend my soul to God that gave it me and
 my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors

I Give and bequeath unto my two sons Newell and Joshua
 all my lands containing four hundred and thirty acres more
 or less in the following manner The Manor Plantation to my
 son Joshua Claud to him and his heirs forever to be bounded
 Thus beginning at the North of Hansons Branch up that
 Branch to a marked Pine from thence to a line of ellackins
 Trees to a pine stump in the Green Pond Branch likewise
 Two negroes Jenny and Winy to him and his heirs forever

I Give to my son Newell Claud Two negroes Lyd and
 Ben to him and his heirs forever
 My will and desire is that my Wife Elizabeth Claud shall
 have the use of my plantation during her life or Widowhood
 likewise two negroes Tom and Sam and at my Wifes death
