In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Byrnum
of Southampton County being in perfect Health Mind and Memory
thanketh God for the same first & recommends my Soul to
Almighty God that gave it me and my body to be buried
in a decent Christianlike manner at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter mentioned and my estate I dispose as
followeth

Imprimis I give and bequath to my son William Byrum One negro
 man Jack One negro Woman Rachad One negro Boy Jacob and
 One negro Girl Amey them and their increase to him and his
 heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Benjamin ^{Benjamin} One Negro Man
Jacob and one Negro Woman Hannah them and their ^{heirs} heirs
to him and his heirs for ever

I lend to my Daughter Abigail Williamson during her nat-
ural life One negro Woman Alice One negro Girl Lucy Daughter
of Alice and One negro Boy Charles they and their increase
and my desire is that the said negro Alice Lucy and Charles
they nor their increase should not be removed out of the govern-
ment wherein the said Abigail Williamson now liveth during
her natural life and I give the said negroes after the death
of my daughter Abigail Williamson they and their increase
to be equally divided Between my Grand children Edwin
Whitehead, Temperance Whitehead, Precilla Whitehead,
and Robert Mickelbury Williamson and all the Children
he shall ever have during her life to them and their heirs for
ever & (The last clause in the margin omitted in this place)

I Give to my Grandson Cordall & Orfelat Bynum One
Negro Boy Jerry and one Negro Girl Lucy and their increase
to him and the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten and if the
said Cordall & Orfelat Bynum should die without an heir
lawfully begotten of his body then my desire is that the said
Negroes Jerry and Lucy and their increase should return
and be equally divided Between all my Children above
mentioned to them and their heirs for ever

Likewise I give to my Grandson Cardell Norfleet
Bynum one feather bed and furniture ALSO one two
year old heifers and her increase to him and his heirs
for ever (Likewise I Give to my Grandson Cardell
Norfleet Bynum one feather bed and)

I gave to my Grandson Bennie Bynum one negro Boy
Abiam to him and the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten
and if the said Bennie Bynum should die without an
heir lawfully begotten of his Body then my desire is
that the said Negro Boy Abiam should return to my
Grand daughter Milley Bynum to her and her heirs
lawful & begotten of her body for ever
