- Item Give and bequeath to Collen Whitchead a negro girl named
Lucy to him and his heirs for ever
- Item Give and bequeath to Cordell Worfolk Bynum all my right
and title to the land and plantation whereon I now live and
one Bay stowe called price one son and seven piggs and daughter
Shoats to him and his heirs for ever
- Item Give and bequeath to poly Bryant a negro Woman named
Sall and in case she die before she arrive to age to go and
ascend to her sister, Ann Bryant, and her heirs for ever
- Item Give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Elizabeth
Sugar Bynum the land and plantation I purchased of
Richard Blow and negro a man Harry Boyd Abram Black
and a girl Sall and all the residue and remainders of my
estate after my debts and legacies paid, to her and her
heirs for ever
- Item My Will and desire is that if my Daughters above mentioned
die without issue of her Body lawfully begotten that their
whole estate devised to her be equally divided between my
Brothers and sisters William Bynum Benjamin Bynum
Abigail Williamson and Sclah Bryant
- Item I make ordain constitute and appoint my Brother Williams
Bynum and my friend John Withinson whole and sole
Executors of this my last Will and testament In witness
whereof I have set my hand affiat my Seal the day and
year first above written Mich. Bynum
