

- Item I Give and bequeath to my Stephen Turner Bynum a negro Girl named Beek to him and his heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath to Colleen Whitehead a negro Girl named Lucy to him and his heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath to Cordell M. Peck Bynum all my rights and title to the land and plantation whereon I now live and one Bay Horse called price one son and seven pigs and eight shoats to him and his heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath to Polly Bryant a negro Woman named Sall and in case she die before she arrive to age to go and descend to her sisters Ann Bryant and her heirs for ever
- Item I Give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Elizabeth Sugar Bynum the land and plantation I purchased of Richard Blom and negroes a Man Harry Boyd Abram Black and a Girl Sall and all the residue and remainder of my estate after my debts and legacies paid, to her and her heirs for ever
- Item My Will and desire is that if my Daughter above mentioned die without issue of her Body lawfully begotten that then whole estate devised to her be equally divided between my Brothers and sisters William Bynum Benjamin Bynum Abigail Williamson and Selah Bryant
- Item I make ordain constitute and appoint my Brother William Bynum and my friend John Wilkinsons whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and testament In Witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first above written
