In the Name of God Amen I Joseph Turner of the County of Southampton being of sound and disposing mind and Memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows Imprimis after recom-
mending my Soul to God and my body to the Earth to be buried at the Dis-
cretion of my executors hereafter named.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Matthew Turner two negroes
named Harry and Lewis one feather bed and furniture to him and his
heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Turner my Negro Slaves
Samuel and Robert and my plantation whereon I now live containing
two hundred and eighty acres to be the same more or less to him and his
heirs forever and my Slaves Peter Cummell Simon & Eli after my
loving Wifes Widowhood to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand Son Joseph Turner son of James
Turner the sum of five Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him and his
heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto Matthew Turner of one Negro named
Mingo one feather bed and furniture and one side saddle which he has
already in possession to him and his heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rogers wife of James
Rogers two negroes named Charles and Celia one feather bed and
furniture to her and her heirs for ever

Item I give and unto my daughter Mary Dickenson wife of
Joel Dickenson two negroes named Elial and Sarah one feather bed
and furniture to her and her heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Patty Turner
two negroes named Will and Sam one feather bed and furniture to
her and her heirs for ever

Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Turner two
negroes named Sam and Lucy one feather bed and furniture to
her and her heirs for ever

Item I give the use of some negroes named Peter Cummell
Simon and Cline to my loving wife Catherine Turner beholding the
use of all the rest of my estate of what nature or kind soever when
soever it be found during her Widowhood and then I give and bequeath
it to my son Benjamin Turner to him and his heirs for ever

I do appoynt and constitute my loving wife Catherine
Turner and my Son Benjamin Turner to be my whole and sole Execut-
ors of this my last Will and Testament in Witness Whereof I have
unto set my hand and affixed my Seal This 13th day of March
One Thousand seven hundred and seventy three
