god therefore first I commend my Soul to God that gave it me

like manner at the Discretion of my Executors

I Give my son Benjⁿ Harris the plantation whereon
he lives and after his Death I Give the said plantation to my Grand
Son West Harris to him and the Heirs of his body Lawfully Begotten
and if he should die without such heirs then my desire is that the said
Land and plantation should return to his next Younger Brother then
Surviving to him and his heirs for ever

I Give to my son Abshalom Harris forty pounds current
money to be raised out of my estate by my Executors hereafter mentioned
before any Division of my personal estate to purchase him a tract
of Land to him and his heirs for ever

I Give and bequeath to my Son Sturdy Harris the plantation
whereon Snow live Also that tract of Land purchased of John Person
adjoining my plantations to him and his heirs for ever and if the
said Sturdy Harris should die without an Heir Lawfully Begotten
or before he arrives to the age of Twenty one years Old then my desire is
that the said plantation should return to my Son Ellick Harris to
him and his Heirs for ever
