HIM I Give to my son Michael Stanis Twenty pounds current
money to be raised out along estate by my executors aforesaid
before any Devision of my personal estate to purchase him a tract
of land to him and his heirs for ever

ITEM I Give and bequeath to my Son Hardy Stanis the plantation
whereon I now live Also that tract of land purchased of Thompson
Adjoining my plantation to him and his heirs for ever and if the
said Hardy Stanis should die without an issue lawfully Begotten
or before he arrives to the age of Twenty one years old then my desire is
that the said plantation should return to my Son Michael Stanis to
him and his heirs for ever
