Item I Give to my son Sumner Kirby my Bed and two duets one Silky called Samous & of my Lamps and all my Stag kind but a sow & pig

Item I Give and bequeath to my grand daughter Mason Dick one sow & piggs a clothe to be bought for her at 20s & a Bonnett

Item I desire my wearing cloths to be divided equally between all my daughter and my grand daughter Mason Dick the said division to be left to the discretion of my Executor

Item I Give to my son William Kirby all the remainder part of my Sheep they being in number 4

Item I desire all the rest and remainder part of my estate may be sold for the best price that can be got for the same and the money arising from the sale thereof together with what cash I have &c to be equally divided between all my children to wit Miley Son Mary Nicholson John Kirby William Kirby Elizabeth Stone Edeth Kinnelmead Sumner Kirby

Item I nominate and appoint my son in law Joshua Nicholson my Executor of this my last Will and Testament in Wines whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 24 day of March 1774
