In the name of god amen this the 15th day of Jan
uary one thousand seven hundred and seventy four I Thomas Carroll of
Virginia in the County of Southampton being very sick and weak in
body but of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last
will and testament viz^t

I Give and bequeath to my loving son Samuel Carroll one part
of the land and plantation wherein I now live joining on Tort
fin Branch to him the said Samuel Carroll my silver stock and
the part wherein I now dwell to him and his heirs and a f^rson
for ever I also give to my said son Samuel Carroll my silver

I also give and bequeath to my loving son Thomas Carroll the
other part of my land beginning at the run of Tortfin Branch
the first run below the spring thence up the stream to the head
thereof thence a straight course to John Baileys line of land where
a path crosses to him the said Thomas Carroll & his heirs &
assigns for ever I also give to my said son Thomas Carroll
one pair silver stove Buttons

I also give and bequeath to my loving daughter Lucy Carroll
the sum of Five pounds current money of Virginia to be raised &
levied out of my estate or otherwise a feather bed and furniture
instead thereof if it may be my said daughter Lucys choice I
also give to my said daughter Lucy Carroll one pair silver stove
Buttons the aforesaid articles I give to her & her heirs and assigns
for ever

I do give the remainder part of my estate to my loving wife, Priscilla
Carroll during the time of her widowhood, or life, but in my desire
at the marriage, or death of my said wife Priscilla Carroll that such
estate shall decend to my five daughter namely Lucy Carroll
Charity Carroll Elizabeth Carroll Patsy Carroll and Priscilla
Carroll to be equally divided amongst the aforesaid daughters
and for their equal parts to be theirs and their heirs for ever

It is also my will and desire, that my son Samuel Carroll
shall pay my son Thomas Carroll Five pounds towards the
improving the said Thomas Carrolls when the said Thomas
Carroll arrives to the age of twenty one years

I do also appoint my aforesaid wife, Priscilla Carroll, John
and John Clayton Executors of this my last will and testament
and do also hereby revoke all other wills that
have been made aforesaid, by me and acknowledge this to be
my last will and testament of which I have hereunto set my
hand
