of sound and perfect sense and memory thanks be to god do make
this my last will and testament

Imprimis I give and bequeath my soul to almighty god that
gave it to me in sure and certain hope of a glorious resur-
rection and my body to be decently buried at the discretion
of my executors hereafter mentioned

Item I give my son John Grizard one feather bed and
furniture which he has now in possession

Item I give my son Amos Grizard all my wearing clothes
except my great coat and Boots

Item I give Hannah Sutor 1 Cow and Calf, call motherless

Item I give my son Hardy Grizard, the plantation wherein
I now live to him and his heirs forever and otherwise give
him my whole estate of all kinds whatsoever on the said plan-
tation

My will and desire is that my daughters Betty Sarah Mella
and Priscilla Grizard may be maintained on the plantation
by my son Hardy Grizard until they arrive to the age of sixteen
years and then for him to pay them Ten pounds cash apiece

I do appoint my son Hardy Grizard my whole and sole Exec-
utor of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have
