 rection and my body to be decently buried at the discretion
 of my Executors hereafter mentioned

I Item I give my son John Grizard one feather bed and
 furniture which he has now in possession

I Item I give my son Ambrose Grizard all my wearing clothes
 except my great coat and Boots

I Item I give Hannah Sinter Thom and cash cat motherless

I Item I give my son Hardy Grizard the plantation whereon
 I am here to him and his heirs for ever and likewise I give
 him my whole estate of all kinds whatsoever in the said plan-
 tation

My will and desire is that my daughters Betty Sarah Milla
 and Priscilla Grizard may be maintained on the plantation
 by my son Hardy Grizard untill they arrive to the age of sixteen
 years and then for him to pay them Ten pounds cash apiece

I do appoint my son Hardy Grizard my whole and sole Executor
 of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first abo-
 ve written
