Item I give and bequeath to my son Edward Dren of the County of Southampton and parish of St. Luke being weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory thanks be to god for the same to make this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit

Imprimis Whereas formerly given to my son Edward Dren in his lifetime a negro woman called Amy who hath since borne a child called Tom now to further confirm the said gift I hereby agree that the said negro wench and child shall be disposed of agreeable to the last will and testament of my son Edward Dren deceased.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Jeremiah Dren all that tract or parcel of land I purchased of Elisha Mutton adjoining the lands of John Turner lying and being in the said County of Southampton to him the said Jeremiah and to his heirs for ever and likewise give to my son Jeremiah my negroes Lewis, Harry, Sharper Fortune to him and his heirs. I also give to my son Jerome Dren two acres of land adjoining his Mill dam to be taken off by my sons Jeremiah Dren and Jefse Dren and if they can not agree as to the bounds each of them are to choose a man and the bounds as they shall agree on Ida hereby declare shall be the bounds. I say I give the said two acres to the said Jeremiah and to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Jefse Dren all that tract or parcel of land wherein I now live all but the two acres which I have given to my son Jeremiah together with the appurtenances my still excepted, and all my land lying on the head of Buckhorn that is to say all my land on the south side the Angelica swamp except the two acres before mentioned the said tract of land granted in four parcels I give to my son Jefse Dren to him and his heirs forever.

Item I also give to my said son Jefse Dren one half of my stock of horses hags Cattle and Sheep one feather bed and furniture and my negroes Anna Tom Jimmy Rufus Ben Seany and Kate to him this heirs.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Patience Smith one negro woman called Phillis and her increase which has been in her possession sometime to her the said Patience and her heirs.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughters Priscilla Fitzhugh the following negroes to wit Jack Jeffery token and her heirs for ever.

Item I desire my estate may not be apprais'd and I desire my wearing apparel may be divided by my Executors agreeable to their direction and for the said Cloaths not to be accounted for in their account current with my estate.

Item my will and desire is that the remaining part of my estate of my estate in whatsoever manner left may be found shall be sold to the highest bidder and that the money arising from the sale be equally divided between my son Jeremiah Dren Jefse Dren my daughter Patience Smith & Priscilla Fitzhugh and that equal part which I intended for my daughter Sarah Fugues and my son Edward Dren to be equally
