

At a Court held for the county of Southampton the 10th Aug^t 1715
 This will was presented in court by Anne Ray one of the executors
 therein named & the other Executors Lewis Bryant & John
 (to act) and pronounced by the oath of James Bryant one of the
 witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and one the
 Notary of the said Color who made oath according to law
 certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate thereof in due
 form given security &c W. Wherpon Sam. Hales

In the name of God amen I John Drake of South-
 ampton county being weak of body but of sound and perfect
 mind and memory and calling to remembrance the uncer-
 tainty of this transitory life dothing proper to make this
 my last will and testament and dispose of the effects
 wherewith God has been pleased to bless me in manner and
 form following Vizt

Imprimis I desire my just debts be first paid & dis-
 charged
 Secondly I give devise and bequeath unto Ridly Drake &
 Cordall Drake the two eldest sons of Barnaby Drake jun^r
 and my lands being the plantation wherein Timashy Drake
 and my self now live containing by estimation one hund-
 red and forty five acres bothen and to their heirs and
 assigns forever

Thirdly I give devise and bequeath unto Ridly Drake
 on his attaining the age of one twenty one years one feather
 bed and furniture one cow and calf one walnut tree
 table to him and to his heirs and assigns forever

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto Cordall Drake on his
 attaining to the age of twenty one years one feather bed
 and furniture one cow and calf one chest one Black
 hunk and one small gilt ditta to him and his heirs for
 ever

Fifthly I give and bequeath unto Bungess Toyner one cow
 yearling to him and to his heirs and assigns forever

Sixthly I give and bequeath unto Baker Toyner one cow
 yearling to him and to his heirs forever

Seventhly I give and bequeath unto Calon Toyner one cow
 yearling to him and to his heirs forever

Eighthly I give and bequeath unto Baldy Drake one Black
 cow yearling to his heirs & assigns forever

Ninthly I give and bequeath unto Mary Drake wife of
 Barnaby Drake jun^r and to Tabitha Toyner wife of Britain
 Toyner my riding saddle and Bridle

Tenthly I give and bequeath unto Barn
