I impriue after my funeral expences are defray'd and just debts paid
I despose of my worldly goods both real and personal which I hath pleased
almighty god of his infinite mercy of and goodnes to bestow on me in the
following manner to wit
Item I desire to my loving wife Anna Garrison during her natural
life all my whole Estate both real and personal except my wearing
clothes so as to be possessed of the use of the same during her life
Item I desire my said wife to take care of and bring up all my young children
until such time they are all and capable to do and act for themselves
Item I desire my Exec^t may deliver to my son Joseph Garrison all my
wearing clothes and that they may be his own property
Item I give and bequeath to my son William Garrison after my wife depart
this life the West part of my tract of land whereon I now live the 20th ad
divided from the East part of the same in the manner following to-w^t beginning
at the flat swamp at the mouth of the Pasture branch there up the S^t Pasture branch
to the head of the same thence a straight line with the said Pasture branch to the
North line of my Land or a line between the land that formerly was John Adams
and my said land provided further William Garrison shall have lawfull share or
arrears to the age of 21 years to him the said William Garrison & to his heirs forever
Item provided by son Joseph Garrison lives to have lawfull share or arrears to the
age of 21 years then I give and bequeath to my said son Joseph after my said way
depart this life the remainder part of my estate land being the East part of the same
to him the S^t Joseph and to his heirs forever
Item after my wife departs the life of said Anna^t my personal Estate that can
there be found may be sold for the best price that can be got for the same and the
money arising therefrom to be equally divided between my following
children, Lewis, Oliver, Rebecca, Elizabeth Anne Joseph and Charlotte
