

Wisthoke In the name of god Amen I Elias Wisthoke of Southampton County being of a weak and low estate of health but of sound and perfect mind and memory do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following First and principally I bequeath my soul to the Almighty god and all my worldly goods that has pleased god to bless me with in manner following To wit

I Item I give and bequeath to my aunt Mary Foster one feather bed and furniture also four pounds current money of Virginia which said money and bed I give to her and her heirs for ever

I Item I give and bequeath to my uncle Moses Foster my negro man name Jack also ten head of Sheep with all the remainder of my estate that I have not heretofore given away of what kind or nature soever or where soever found which said negro, Sheep and other estate I give to my said uncle to him and his heirs for ever

I Item Lastly I ordain constitute and appoint my uncle Moses Foster my sole and sole executor here by revoking all other wills heretofore by me made and declaring this to be my only last will and testament and in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this ninth day of July 1776

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 9th day of January 1777 This Will was presented in Court by Mary Foster the Executor therein named and proved by the oath of John Simmons one of the witnesses thereto and Order to be recorded & on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon &c
