In the name of god amen Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my eldest son William Banow a crop cut Tom and a set of wedges and also a negro woman named Lydia and also Iron pot and hooks and also a stone jug holding three Gallons to him and his heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel Banow a negro man called Pompey and Also a negro boy called Tim now in his possession and Also two Ewes and Lambs and also Iron pot and hooks and Also a three gallon stones jug to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Banow the land and plantation whereon I now live together with its appurtenances and likewise a still and its appurtenances and also a negro boy named Isaac and a feather bed and furniture of his own choosing a copper Kettle and a large pot and half my hogs & cattle I shall have at that time and all the sheep undivided and all the stone and glass ware of all kinds and Also all the Cyder Barrels and hogsheads of all kinds and Likewise give all my Tobacco pieced or standing at that time and half my crop that shall be standing or gathered at that time to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my grand child Oheba the Banow all my pewter of all kinds and spice morter and Pestle and also a dray's kettle and a looking glass and a coffee pot and the ware belonging to it to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anne Kennebaw a flat hatchet and an small iron fish to her and her heirs forever.
