providing paying of one John Banow Senior one pound six shillings
to her and her heirs for ever also a large bib

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Bass
a negro woman named Venus and her increase to her and her
heirs for ever

I leave my negro man will to be sold at public sale
and I give two thirds of that money to my son John Banow
and the other one third to my son Daniel Banow and likewise
the other half of my crop unmention'd to my son Daniel Banow
to they and their heirs for ever

I leave my negro negroes all the rest of my estate undenom-
inated of what kind soever to be sold to the highest bidder and the
money arising from the sale to be equally divided between my
three sons William Banow and Daniel Banow

Lastly I do appoint my son John Banow and Benjamin Banow
my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and testa-
ment disannulling all former wills by me made In witness
whereof I do here unto set my hand and affix my seal this
twenty ninth day of July 1776

motion of the said Executor John Banow (the other Executor refusing
to join in the probate) certificate is granted him for obtaining
a probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon he
is directed to have it recorded
