At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 9th day May 1776 This will was presented in Court by William Scott the Executor named and proved by the oath of Jacob Randolph one of the ~~executors~~ ^{witnesses} And on the 11th July 1776 was further proved by the oath of Richard Johnson another of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said Executor (who being one of the people called Quakers) solemnly affirmed & testified as granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving Security Whereupon &c
