Thomas Westbrook senior of St. James parish and County of Southampton being sick and in a low state of health but of sound and disposing mind do make this my last will and testament in manner following toward Item Give my hole and sole estate to my loving wife Kellen Westbrook the same to her and her heirs for ever except my land wherein I now live and begin to my son Henry Westbrook after the death of my wife to him and his heirs for the aforesaid land

Item Give and bequeath to my son Thomas Westbrook six pounds Virginia Cunney yearly to be paid him by his mother yearly during her life Item Give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Spent one hundred pounds Virginia Cunney to be paid at my death to her and her heirs for ever

Item Give and bequeath to my daughter Kellen Speed my plantation that I had at James Speed with the following negroes Will Buck pug Jeffe Charlal and Blue Also the Stock of all kinds that is upon the said plantation with all the monables that I have before given her which said land and negroes Stock and other estate I give my said daughter Kellen during her natural life and after her death Give and bequeath the said land negroes Stock and other estate to be equally divided between all the Children that she has living at her death to them and their heirs for ever

Item Give to my daughter Kellen Speed the use of a negro Boy name Ephraim Till my grand son Beny Speed comes to the age of twenty one and then Give and bequeath the said negro Ephraim to my Grand son Benjamin Speed to him and his heirs for ever

Item Give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Sudkins one hundred pounds Virginia Cunney to be paid at my death to her and her heirs for ever

My will and desire is that my estate shall not be appraised

I do hereby appoint my loving wife and my son Henry Westbrook my sole Executrix and Executor hereby revoking all other wills heretofore made by me and have hereunto set my hand and fix my seal this twenty fifth day of August Anno Dom. one thousand seven hundred and seventy five mark
