Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son James Fowler and his heirs
forever the plantation whereon I now live with half my land which
will be laid off by the above men after the marriage or death of my
wife also one feather bed and furniture one Cow and Calf one ewe
and lamb one frying pan one Mare named Blaze
Thirdly I have the use of the plantation whereon I now live unto my
wife Sarah Fowler with the whole of my stock and household
goods which shall remain after the legacies are paid and five
negroes namely Belinda Anne Senny and Shany during her
life or widowhood
Fourthly My wife and I desire is that my Executor after the marriage
or death of my wife do equally divide the estate then remaining
with the negroes and their increase between himself and my
son James. I likewise constitute and appoint my son William
Fowler Executor of this my last will and testament Given under
my hand and Seal this twenty third day of February one thousand
and seven hundred and seventy seven
