In the name of God Amen I Timothy Athenix of the
parish of Botwney County of Southampton being weak of body but
of sound mind and memory to make and constitute this my last
will and testament in manner and form following Viz.

I tend to my loving wife Elizabeth during her life or widowhood
the use of my negroes Dick Jacob and Simon
I leave to my son Timothy the plantation wherison Stine Acre
I leave to my son Timothy and Senick to him and his heirs and in
my negroes Jim Venus and Senick to him and his heirs and in
case of the death of my said son without heir then the said negroes
and land to be sold and the money equally divided amongst my son
and land to be sold and the money equally divided amongst my son
living children or the representatives of those that may be deceased

I Give to my daughter Shalane my negroes Big Samey Jack
and Dick to her and her heirs for ever

I Give to my daughter Sally my negroes Evan Young Simon and
Ben to her & her heirs for ever Lucy V.

I Give to my daughter Patty my negro Stephen to her and her heirs
for ever

I Give to my daughter Mary my negro Semy and after the
death or marriage of my wife my negroes Dick to her and her
heirs for ever and in case of the death of my said daughter
Mary without heir then the above negroes to be sold and the
money equally divided among my surviving Children, or the re
presentatives of those that may be deceased

My Will is also that my negroes Jacob Simon & Clics
sold and the money after paying my just debts be equally divide
as above viz between my son Timothy my daughter Shalane
Sally Patty Betty and Mary or their representatives

I Give also to my son Timothy one Ivory Stone Saddle and
Bridle three Ivory fifteen piggs and one Shoot four Lines and
rambs two Cows and two Horses one Bed and Furniture from
fisher two Razors and one spit three chairs and one Spinning
wheel to him and his heirs The Residue of my personal estate
of what sort soever I leave to my wife during her life or widowhood
and after her death or marriage I give the same to my son except
ing the Young Bay house which my will is shall be sold and the
money equally divided as above

I Do hereby appoint and constitute my son Timothy Athenix
my sole Executor of this my last will and testament revoking all
other wills whatsoever by me made and declaring this my last will
and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this 27th day of January 1777
