I give and bequeath all the remaining part of my Real & all herds whatever is to be equally divided Between my daughters Sarah & my son Saml Edmunds to them and their heirs forever

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons Will & Saml Edmunds Esq And my daughter Sarah Edmunds Executrix of this my last will and testament and I desire that their may be no appraismant of my estate In Wmleffshen of I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day of year above written
