I Item Give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Edmunds son of Thos Edmunds ten pounds current money of Virginia

I Item Give and bequeath two negroes to wit Robin & Fran to be sold & the money arising thereon to be equally divided between my son William John & Samuel Edmunds to them and their heirs forever

I Item Give and bequeath all the remaining part of my Estate of all kinds whatsoever to be equally divided between my daughters Sarah & my son Saml Edmunds to them and their heirs forever

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons Will^m & Saml Edmunds Executors and my daughter Sarah Edmunds executrix of this my last will and testament and I desire that there may be no appraisement of my Estate

Amen I Nathan Jones of Southampton County do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form as followeth First I give unto my brother Thomas Jones the sum of five shillings Cash I Item Give unto my loving wife Mary Jones the use of my whole estate of every kind after the payment of my just debts and the above legacy during her life or widowhood & at her decease or marriage to my cousin Mary Williams daughter of Blythe Williams to her & her heirs provided she the said Mary Williams have lawfully Issue but in case she die without such heir at her decease I give all my said estate to Ann Whitney now wife of Joshua Whitney Lastly I do appoint my friend Samuel Jones here to be my last will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of Sept^r 1777
