Eightly I give & bequeath unto my son Tom Bond our negro boy called George also one

feather bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever

Ninthy I give & bequeath unto my son James Bond our negro boy called Charles also

one feather bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever

I bind unto my loving wife Martha Bond during her natural life the
plantation whereon I now live with 395 acres of land adjoining to land
as is mentioned as above in the first clause of my will also the rest & labour of
the following negroes to wit Laurence, Sally, Rachel, Lucy & Millie upon
my just debts and legacies unpaid I also bind unto my wife the sum of $\frac{1}{2}$ of the
residue of my estate of what nature or kind soever they will & diminish that
after the death of my wife my negroes Rachel, Lucy, & Millie with their
increase be equally divided between my two sons Thos & James & their heirs
of their bodies but if either of my two sons Thomas or James should die unmar-
ried or without issue then my desire is that the survivor of them should
have the whole of the legacies herein given. But other wise both of my
sons should die under age or without issue then the estate given them
to be equally divided amongst my surviving children & their heirs
& I further desire after the death of my wife the whole of my estate not
herein before given away be equally divided amongst all my children
herein named or their heirs And lastly I do hereby constitute
and appoint my loving wife Executrix to my two sons Richard & John Bond
& also whole & sole executors of this my last will & testament making
all former wills by me made in Wiltshire whereof I have executed
set my hand and seal this 22 day of September 1777.
