dower and to enable her to educate & maintain my children until they arrive
to the age of twenty one years or are married which ever shall first happen
and after the decease of my wife I leave the slave land her be equally divided
between all the children I shall leave by her viz Christian Eliz. Edm
Byrd Joshua Claude & James & their heirs

- Item - I give to my said wife all my following Negroes & all my grain Cotton
Slate & my spinning & weaving utensils & one hundred pounds cash.
- Item I give to my son Edwin Lunary all my lands given to me by my father with
the fishing place also the lands purchased of Robert Willis to my said
son and to his heirs forever but should he die under the age twenty one years
and without issue living at his death I then give the said lands to my
son James Lunary & to his heirs forever.
- Item I give to my son Byrd Lunary after the decease of my beloved wife Phabby
the lands & plantation which I have given her the use of also the fishing place
to him & to his heirs forever but should he die under the age of twenty one years
and without issue living at his death then I give the said plantation land
to my son Joshua Claude Lunary & to his heirs forever.
- Item I give my bequest to my son Joshua Claude Lunary & to his heirs a negro
a negro girl named Lotty & her increase,
- Item I give my bequest to my son James Lunary & to his heirs a negro girl named
Nelly & her future increase,
- Item I give my bequest to my daughter Christiane and to her heirs a negro girl named
Amy & her future increase and a flat wheel
- Item I give my bequest to my daughter Molly & to her heirs a negro boy named Ben
a young duplex mare with a flat wheel a chest with iron rings at the end,
One hundred & fifty pounds cash & a flat wheel
- Item I give my bequest to my daughter Betty & to her heirs a negro girl named
Lucy & her increase and a flat wheel
- Item I give the slaves land my wife be divided as before directed by three persons to be
nominated by the worshippfull court of Southampton county & that at the time
of my said wife the personal estate both her may by my testam the survey of them
be sold and the money arising from such sale equally divided among all my
children except my daughter Molly
- Item The residue of my estate whether real or personal I desire may at a
time be sold by myself at such credit as they may judge most easy
money arising from such sale together with the money now mon
ies due at cash I may have by me be directed a man & all my
or their representatives except my daughter Molly And I do by
mytestam and appoint my colored wife Phabby executive my
Edwin & Byrd & my friend Lewis Throckmorton of this instant and
