and after the decease of my wife I reserve the slave land her be equally divided
between all the children So to leave by her Will Christian Eliza Eden
Byrd Joshua Claude & James & their heirs

Item I give to my said wife all my following hogs Goddard & all my grain cotton
flax & my spinning & weaving & one hundred pounds cash

Item I give to my son Edwin Sunday all my lands given to me by my father except
the fishing place also the lands I purchased of Robert Withers to my said
son and to his heirs forever but should he die under the age of twenty one years
and without issue living at his death I then give the said lands to my
son James Sunday to his heirs forever

Item I give to my son Byrd Sunday after the decease of my beloved wife Phoebe
the lands & plantation which I have given her the use of also the fishing place
to him & to his heirs forever but should he die under the age of twenty one years
and without issue living at his death then I give the said plantation & land
to my son Joshua Claude Sunday & to his heirs forever

Item I give Viqueath to my son Joshua Claude Sunday & to his heirs a negro
a negro girl named Lotty & her increase

Item I give Viqueath to my son James Sunday & to his heirs a negro girl named
Nelly & her full increase

Item I give Viqueath to my daughter Christian and to her heirs a negro girl named
a negy & her full increase and a flax wheel

Item I give Viqueath to my daughter Molly & to her heirs a negro boy named Ben
a young dupder & her wheel & furniture a chest with iron rings at the end
one hundred & fifty pounds cash & a flax wheel

Item I give Viqueath to my daughter Betty & to her heirs a negro girl named
Lucy & her increase and a flax wheel

Item I leave the slave land my wife be devised as before directed by this personal be
nominated by the worshipful court of Southampton county & that at the decease
of my said wife the personal estate then may by my executors or the executors of them
be sold and the money arising from such sale equally divided among all my
children except my daughter Molly

Item The residue of my estate whether real or personal I desire may at a con
venient time be sold by my executors at such credit as they may see fit most con
venient money arising from such sale together with the money due me or
owed such at cash I may have by me to be divided among all my
children & their representatives except my daughter Molly And I do hereby
nominate and appoint my beloved wife Phoebe executrix and
Edwin & Byrd & my friend Lewis Thorne executors of this my last will
