Mem I give and bequeath unto my grandson Nathan Jackson his share of a cow & calf which is at present in the hands of James Piden

Mem I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Gurly for her term of life all the rest & residue of my estate and at her decease it is my will and desire it should all fall to my grandson Nathan Jackson

Lastly I appoint my trusty friend William Edwards whole & sole Executor of this my last will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 9 day of June in the year of our Lord 1777.

Imprius I give and bequeath to my loving wife Faith during her life in and to the full labour of my two negroes Daniel & Lucy I likewise give to my said wife Faith one half of my personal Estate after my decease is paid of to her & her heirs I also give to my wife an equal right to the land & plantation whereon I now live with my son Wheelock Warren during her natural life I also give to my wife all the money that shall be found in my possession at my death
