I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Dupuy one negro call'd Billy to her & her heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath to my grandson Will Day son of Thos Day the sum of ten pounds current money of Virginia to be paid him by my Executor at the age of twenty one years

Lastly I do appoint my wife Executrix and my son Michael Warren Executor of this my last will & Testament My desire is further that my estate be not apprais'd In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand affix'd my seal this 15 day of August 1775
