First I lend to my wife Ann Fowler the Land & plantation whereon I now reside during her life & after her death to be sold & the money arising from the sale to be equally divided between my sons Wm Fowler & Charles Fowler

I also give and bequeath to my son William Fowler five Shillings current money of Virginia

I also give & bequeath to my wife above mentioned all the rest & residue of my estate after the payment of my debts to her then heirs & assigns forever

I also appoint Burwell Barnes executor of this my last will & testament Revoking all other wills by me heretofore made confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 1 day of October 1777.
