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Ben^r In the Name of God Amen I Benjamin Kitchen of Southam-
pton county being sick and weak but of sound mind & memory do
give and dispose of my goods & estate as follows.

Will I give to my son Benjamin Kitchen five shillings
I give to my son Nathaniel Kitchen five shillings
I give to my son Frederick Kitchen thirty pounds of my personal estate
I give to my son Ethelred Kitchen thirty pounds I also desire that
he may have his freedom at my death.

I give to my son Joseph Kitchen and his heirs forever all the land &
hold on the North side of my little tranche situated at one hundred
and five acres and also the mill and one little wood & peaggs & hop
sow that goes with the best feather bed & furniture whereon he commonly
lies & grey mare named Belling & cow & calf & sheep & swine & plants
my growing stone my set of shoe makers & carpenters Tools one ring
made dish one plate & 1 Iron pot I thought of Robert Bailey son
made & padole I also desire that he the said Joseph may have his
freedom and estate immediately after my death & to have his living out
out of my estate for the first year my desire is that if he should die without
lawful issue the land given him as above may descend to his brother
Ethelred and his heirs forever & in case he should die without
issue that the said land go to my son Frederick & his heirs forever

I give to my daughter Sarah five shillings
