and memory do make and ordain this as my last will and testament in
manner and form following (to wit)

I lend unto my loving wife Ann Blunt during her natural life the use of the plantation whereon I now live with the land adjoining also the use of the plantation & land I purchased of Henry Browns Executors. also the use & labour of the following Negroes (to wit) Jack Walley great Judy Patt Little Judy Meora and Hannah. I give unto my said wife Ann Blunt & her heirs forever all my household & kitchen furniture all my plantation utensils together with my Stocks of all kinds (except a Black hereafter given my Son Henry Blunt

Secondly. I give unto my Son Henry Blunt & to his heirs my negro boy Moses & my
boy mare called Tomp.

Give unto my Son Joseph Gray Blind and to his heirs my Negro Boy Simon
