of County of Southampton being sick & weak tho' of perfect & sound mind  
and memory do make and ordain this as my last will and testament in  
manner and form following (to wry)

I lend unto my loving wife Ann Blunt during her natural life  
the use of the plantation whereon I now live with the land adjoining also  
the use of the plantation & land I purchased of Henry Browns Executors  
also the use & labour of the following Negroes (Court) Jack Waller great  
Judy Batt Little Judy Moorea and Hannah. I give unto my said wife  
Ann Blunt & her heirs forever all my household & kitchen furniture all my  
plantation utensils together with my Stocks of all kinds except a few  
hereafter given my Son Henry Blunt

Secondly I give unto my Son Henry Blunt & to his heirs my negro boy Moses & my  
bay mare called tempy

Thirdly I give unto my Son Joseph Gray Blunt and to his heirs my Negro boy Simon  
I give unto my Son Thomas Blunt & to his heirs my Negro boy Peter  
I give unto my Son Edmund Blunt & to his heirs my Negro boy Ned  
I give unto my Son William Blunt & to his heirs my Negro boy Daniel  
I give unto my Son James Blunt & to his heirs my Negro boy Tiba
