I lend unto my loving wife Annemaria Wellons the use of my lands and my two Negroes Peter and Kate and all the residue & remainders of my estate of whatsoever it will after my just debts being paid for Enduring her natural life and after her decease to be equally divided peaceable and quietly between all my Children or them or their heirs & assigns to be to them and their forever

I do also appoint my two Sons John Wellons and Charles Wellons Executors of this my last will and Testament as in witness whereof I with hereunto set my hand and affix my Seal this the 10th Day of December 1773

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Whereas I William Vick of Southampton County being through age weak of Body but of Sound and disposing mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of life as well as certainty of age think proper and Necessary to settle my temporal affairs by this thing writing in manner and form following

Item I intend all my estate for my Children but desire my wife Elizabeth Vick may have the use of it during Life

Item I give and demise my plantation with two hundred & forty Acres of land belonging to it to my Son Simon Vick and to his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give to son one hundred Acres of land more or less on east side of the Little Swamp passing on from said Swamp by Corner tree and line of Ephraim Williams to tree and line of my Plantation tract thence by various Courses of said Swamp to the beginning so hold to my said Son Simon Vick and his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give to son seventy Acres of land more or less being part of a tract of which I gave Simon Barett I parcel Bounded by his line my plantation tract line my son William Vick's line and Pickly Ash Branch's Road to son Simon Vick and his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give and demise to my Son Robert two hundred Acres of land more or less
