In the Name of god Amen James Moore of the County of Southampton being in Sound Mind and Memory thanks be to Almighty God for the same do make and ordain this my last will & testament in the manner following that is to say

It is my will & desire that all my land in and Church in Virginia to be sold and all my Stock & household goods & Chattels after paying my just Debts the remainder of the money to be Divided between My wife & my Sons James & Jesse Moore if either of my Sons shall die before they come to the age of twenty their part goes to the living Son & if they both shall die their money to be Divided between my three Daughters Martha Elizabeth & Sarah Moore.

Item I lend to my beloved wife one Negro fellow Named Thomas a wench Betty & Franky Milley Ben & Peter during her life at her death the wench Franky Milley Ben & Peter & their Increase to be Divided between my three Daughters Martha Elizabeth & Sarah Moore if either of my Daughters shall die before they are of age or Married their part to be Divided between the living Sisters and as my wife do death Tom & Betty to be sold & the money to be divided between my two Sons James & Jesse Moore the goods & Chattels to be sold for 12 months Credit and lastly I do appoint Richard Bond Richard Richs Curwin Gray Executors of this my last will and testament

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 8th day of Oct 1778

This will was proved by the oaths of Benjamin Stewart James Bell Elizabeth Lewis the witnesses thereto & ordered to be Recorded and on the motion of Isaac Williams & Jesse Williams the executors therein who made oath according to law Certificate was granted them for obtaining Letter of administration on the estate of the said James Moore with this will annexed giving Security whereupon &c.

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Davis of the parish of Nettoway and County of Southampton being of Sound Mind & memory do make & ordain this my last will & testament revoking all former wills by me made in manner & form following I give and bequath unto my beloved wife Jane Davis the use of the land and plantation whereon I now live together with the use of my two Negroes Sam & Bristol during her Natural life

I give & bequath to my Daughter in law Hannah Davis Relict of my Son Thomas the use of one third of the land and plantation she now lives on during her Natural life

I give and bequath to my Grandson Phillip Davis all the land & plantation he now lives on containing by estimation two hundred & fifty Acres being a tract I purchased of the Nettoway Indians

I give & bequath unto my Son Henry Davis and his heirs forever after my wife's death the land & plantation I now live on also one other tract I purchased of my Son Drury adjoining the same also my two Negroes Sam & Bristol provided he pay to my daughter Mary Sum twenty five pounds to my Daughter Hannah Davis twenty five pounds & to my Grand Daughter Sarah Long ten pounds on his term in possession of the said Negroes Sam & Bristol
