being Aged and unform though in sound memory do make and ordain this  
My last will and testament In manner & form as follows

Item I give unto my Son Joshua Phillips all my land lying on the  
west side of the Bracey Bond branch to him and his heirs forever also one  
negro Girl named Lucy to him and his heirs forever also I give him the use of my  
negro Boy Randolph during his life and at his death I give the said negro Boy  
Randolph to my grandson Thomas Phillips and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Fairhey Ellis my negro boy Dary to her & her heirs forever  
Item I give the use of my negro fellow Jimney to my daughter Hannah Davis during  
her life and at her death I give the said Negro Jimney to my grandson Phillip Davis  
And his heirs forever

Item I give unto my Son John Phillips all my land lying on the east side of the bushy  
Bond Branch to him and his heirs forever also my Bed and furniture upon his giving his  
daughter Lucy when she arrives to the age of Eighteen years of marriage the sum of  
nines pounds current money of Virginia

I give the use of my negro girl Charlott to my grandson Edwin Ellis till my grand Son John  
Phillips arrives to the age of twenty one years then to him and his heirs forever  
I consitute and appoint my Son Joseph Phillips my whole & sole executor of this  
my last will and testament In witness I have hereunto set my hand and Seal  
this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1779
