 my last will and testament In manner & form as follows

Impremis I give unto my Son Joshua Phillips all my land lying on the
 west side of the Brassey Pond branch to him and his heirs forever also one
 negro Girl named Fely to him and his heirs forever also I give him the use of my
 negro Boy Randol during his life and at his death I give the said negro Boy
 Randol to my grandson Thomas Phillips and his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Faithy Ellis my negro boy Dary to her & his heirs forever
 Item I give the use of my negro fellow jimmy to my daughter Hannah Davis during
 her life and at her death I give the said Negro jimmy to my grandson Phillip Davis
 and his heirs forever

Item I give unto my Son John Phillips all my land lying on the east side of the Brassey
 Pond Branch to him and his heirs forever also my Bed and furniture upon his giving his
 daughter Lucy when she arrives to the age of Eighteen years of marriage, the sum of
 nine pounds current money of Virginia

I give the use of my negro girl Charlot to my grandson Edwin Ellis till my grand Son
 Phillips arrives to the age of twenty one years then to him and his heirs forever
 I constitute and appoint my Son Joseph Phillips my whole & sole executor of this
 my last will and testament In witness I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
 this 10th day of January 1779
